Dear Ms. Jones,

The Board of Education remains committed to prioritizing the safety and well-being of students, both in the classroom and in sporting events. That is, and always will be, our first priority. That being said, we are aware of your desire to attend your children's sporting events for the remainder of this school year and this summer. In an effort to avoid litigating your request for emergency relief, the Board is willing to modify its ban for the remainder of this school year and this summer only.

For the remainder of this school year and summer only, the Board is agreeable to permitting you to attend your children's sporting events and school-related activities in which your children are participants. The ban will remain in effect as to sporting events or school-related activities not involving your children. As is required of all spectators, you must abide by all Board policies and spectator codes of conduct while in attendance. This includes, but is not limited to, the Board's policy on civility (10.21), the Board's policy on recording (10.5), and the Board's Athletic Events Spectator Policy, which have all been provided to your counsel.

**Any and all photographs and/or videos taken on school property must comply with all Board policies and may only be used in compliance with said policies. Any conduct, photography or otherwise, that disrupts any event, prevents or discourages others from participating in or observing the event, that violates any legal rights, or disrupts the educational process in any way will not be tolerated. This includes, but is not limited to, any photograph or post posted to social media that appears to target and/or harass any child or staff member.**

The Board maintains its right to enforce all Board policies which may result in additional restrictions including, but not limited to, implementation of a total ban. Board enforcement is equally applicable to all spectators—any spectator violating Board policies, not just you, will be subject to additional restrictions.

By modifying the ban to permit you to attend your children's sporting and school-related activities in which your children are participants, the Board does not waive any of its arguments or defenses in the ongoing litigation.
