

PAST FELONY CONVICTION? SEE IF YOU CAN VOTE!

REGISTER BY OCT. 5

Voting rights were restored to
175,000 Kentuckians with past
felony convictions last December.

1. DOUBLE CHECK

Confirm your rights were restored. It's free and online. All you need are your name and birthday.

2. REGISTER TO VOTE

Even if your rights were restored, you must still register to vote by October 5 so you can vote in the November election. Registering to vote is free, online, and only takes a minute.

3. REQUEST A MAIL-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT

All Kentucky voters can vote-by-mail due to the pandemic. Request your free ballot online by October 9.
